



Incident Types by Group July 2014





































Emergency Response Average and 90% Arrival Times









Brush Fire 2nd Alarm Mutual Aid: 07/28/2014 about 1536 hours 703, Brush 71 and Engine 74 responded to Jameson Lake Road to assist DCFPD 5 with a brush fire and structural protection.

MVA: 07/26/2014 about 1730 hours, 703, Rescue 71, Medic 3171 responded to MP 226 SR-97A for a two vehicle injury MVA. CCFPD 8 was on scene with Ballard Ambulance. Seven patients were treated and transported to LCCH.

Commercial Fire Response: 07/25/2014 about 1444 hours Engine 71, Brush 71 responded to 455 E Wapato Lake for smoke in the Mill Bay Casino Smoke Shop to assist CCFPD 5. CFR units were cancelled en route.

MVA: 07/23/2014 about 1320 hours Rescue 71, Brush 71 and Medic 3171 responded to E Woodin Ave and S Navarre Street for a MVA. All involved parties denied injury and care.

Moped Accident: 07/21/2014 about 1624 hours Rescue 71 and Medic 3171 responded to N Saunders Street and East Johnson Ave for a moped rider that bit the dust. Patient had minor injuries and was treated and transported to LCCH.

Brush Fire 1st Alarm: 07/20/2014 about 0746 hours Chief 701, Brush 71, Engine 74 responded to Antoine Creek Road and Quiet Valley for a report of a brush fire. Chief 701 tied-in with a Wildland Strike Team in the area and they stated they would handle it. Chief 701 cancelled all units and returned in service.

MVA: 07/20/2014 around 0211 hours Rescue 71 and Medic 3171 responded to W Manson Road and E Highland Ave for a car vs powerpole. Driver/patient denied injury and refused medical care.

Brush Fire 1st Alarm: 07/18/2014 about 2046 hours, 703, Brush 75, Engine 72 and Tender 71 responded to 120 SR-97A and extinguished a 10' x 10' fire. Cause of the fire was from electrical powerlines arching.

MVA vs Pedestrian: 07/18/2014 about 0751 hours, Engine 71 and Medic 3171 responded to 216 W Manson Road for a pedestrian hit by a car. Patient denied injuries and did not need medical care.

Wildard Interface Fire 1st **Alarm**: 07/18/2014 about 2100 hours Brush 71, Rescue, DNR, US Forest responded to conduct structural protection as the Pateros fire burned into Quiet Valley of Antoine Creek Road.

Wildand Interface Fire 3rd Alarm SMOB: 07/17/2014, about 1972 hours Chief 701, Brush 71, Engine 74, Tender 75 responded to Pateros with reports the town was being burned over.

MVA vs Pedestrian, Auto Aid, 07/16/2014 about 0457 hours, Chief 701 Rescue 71, Engine 71 and Medic 3171 responded to 80 McNeil Canyon Road for a pedestrian run over in a parking lot. Patient was treated and transported to LCCH.

Brush Fire 2nd Alarm, Mutual Aid: 07/12/2014 about 1432 hours, 703, Brush 71 responded to 625 20 NW Road and assisted DCFPD 5 with a brush fire.

Brush Fire 3rd Alarm, **Mutual Aid**: 07/11/2014 about 1314 hours, 703 and Brush 71 responded to MP 128 SR-174 to assist DCFPD 3 with a brush fire.

Structure/Forest Fire 3rd **Alarm**: 07/10/2014, Chief 701, 703, Brush 71, 73, 75, Rescue 71, Medic 3171, Tender 71, 74, 75, DNR and US Forest responded to Shady Pass for 240 acre brush fire. Cause of the fire is under investigation.

MVA: 07/10/2014 about 0939 hours, Chief 701, Rescue 71 and Medic 3171 responded to 902 E Woodin Ave for a three vehicle rear end accident with minor injuries.

Structure/Brush Fire 2nd Alarm: 07/10/2014 around 0031 hours, Chief 701 703, Brush 75, 73 Engine 72, 75, Medic 3171 and Tender 71, 74, 75 responded to 275 Buzzard Perch Lane for a storage building fire that had spread to the surrounding brush. Crews contained the brush fire and then extinguished the storage building fire. Cause of the fire was from a tractor that had been used for mowing earlier in the day.

MVA: 07/09/2014 about 1915 hours, Chief 701 Rescue 71 and Medic 3171 responded to 6101 E Woodin Ave for a three vehicle accident with minor inuires.

Brush/Forest Fire 3rd Alarm: 07/09/2014 about 0917 hours, 703 and Brush 71 responded to 886 Highland Orchard Road and assisted DCFPD 3 with a brush/forest fire.

Brush/Forest Fire 3rd Alarm, SMOB: 07/08/2014 about 1211 hours, 703, Brush 71, 75 and Tender 75 responded to 5090 Mills Canyon road and assisted CCFPD 8 with a brush/forest fire

Brush Fire 3rd Alarm, SMOB: 07/06/2014 about 2000 hours, Chief 701, Brush 71, Brush 73, Tender 75 responded to the Rock Hills fire and assisted DCFPD 5 with a brush fire.

Brush Fire 1st Alarm: 07/06/2014 about 1949 hours, Chief 701, Resuce 71, Brush 73, Engine 72, Tender 71 responded to 254 Powerhouse Road and extinguished a 100' x 100' brush fire.

Brush/Forest Fire 3rd Alarm, Mutual Aid: 07/06/2014 about 1949 hours, 710 and Brush 71 responded to 1511 Skyline Drive to assist CCFPD 1 with a brush/forest fire.

Brush Fire 2nd **Alarm, Mutual Aid**: 07/05/2014 about 1626 hours Brush 71 responded to 1100 Highland Orchard Road to assist DCFPD 3 with a brush fire.

MVA: 07/05/2014 about 1133 hours Rescue 71 and Medic 3171 responded to MP 5 SR-150 for a three car vehicle rear end accident with only minor injuries.

Marine Assist: 07/04/2014 about 2346 hours Chief 701 and Rescue 71 responded to the PUD Boat launch near the dam for a vehicle in the water. Upon arrival we found a full size pick up with a boat trailer about 40' out in water about ten feet deep. All occupants had made it out of the water. Driver was going to load his boat when the vehicle popped out of gear and rolled back into the water. There were no injuires.

Brush Fire 2nd **Alarm Auto Aid**: 07/04/2014, about 2214 hours Brush 71 responded to MP 221 SR 97 to assist Orondo Fire Department with a brush fire.

MarineAssist: 07/03/2014, about 0734 hours CCSO requested Marine 71 to retrieve a lost boat that was drifting toward the dam. Chief 701, Rescue 71 and Marine 71 responded and recovered the boat.

Brush Fire 1st Alarm: 07/03/2014, about 0615 hours, Chief 701, Rescue 71, Engine 71, Tender 71 responded to a brush fire at 1525 W Main Street and extinguished a 20'x 60' brush fire. Cause of the fire was fireworks.

Brush Fire 1st Alarm: 07/01/2014, about 1336 hours, Chief 701, Rescue 71, Engine 75, Tender 74, 75 responded to a brush fire at 12200 S Lakeshore Road and extinguished a 50' x 50' brush fire. Cause of the fire was heavy equipment operating in the area that sparked the fire.
