



Emergency Response Average and 90% Arrival Times



















10/24/2014 around 1222 hours, Officer 703 and Engine 71 responded to 114 N Saunders Street for a report of **smoke in the building**. Upon arrival, Officer 703 found smoke in the hallway of the apartment building, Engine 71 made entry into one of the apartments and located a cooking fire on the stove. Engine 71 extinguished the fire and overhauled the fire area.

10/23/2014 around 2329 hours, Officer 703, Engine 71 and Douglas County Fire Protection District 4 (DCFPD 4) responded to 8 Shriner Lane for a reported **storage building fire**. Upon their arrival, they found that DCFPD 4 had the fire contained to the involved building. Officer 703 and Engine 73 stood-by until they were released by command.

10/17/2014 around 2249 hours, Chief 701, Brush 71 and Chelan County Fire Protection District 8 (CCFPD 8) responded to 2269 Entiat Way for a **reported residential structure fire**. Upon arrival, they found that CCFPD 8 had knocked down the fire, Chief 701 was assigned Safety Officer and other personnel were used for overhauling the burned structure.

10/15/2014 around 0823 hours, Chief 701, Officer 703, Engine 71, 72, 73, Tender 71 responded to 905 Cooper Gulch Road for a **reported residential structure fire**. Chief 701 arrived on scene to find no fire problem. The home owner had left a tea kettle on the stove and had contacted a neighbor to turn it off. The neighbor thought the house was on fire and called 911.
