July 1st through 3rd, 10 a.m. to 10 p.m.

July 4th, 10 a.m. to 9 p.m.

Discharge:

July 3rd to July 4th, 1 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.

Safety Tips

Use fireworks outdoors only.

Obey local laws.

Always have water (a hose or bucket) and/or a fire extinguisher nearby. Know how to operate the fire extinguisher properly.

Only use fireworks as intended. Don't alter or combine them.

Never relight a "dud" firework. Wait 20 minutes and then soak it in water.

Use common sense. Spectators keep a safe distance from shooter. Shooter should wear safety glasses

Alcohol & fireworks do not mix. Have a "designated shooter."

Only persons over the age of 12 should be allowed to handle sparklers of any type.

Do not ever use homemade fireworks of illegal explosives.
