#### Fire Chief Report:

- Chief Lemon reported on the April financials which included funds received for the December California fire suppression response. We also received \$3,100 in funds from FMAG for the 2015 Chelan Complex.
- Chief Lemon handed out the 2018 June incident statistic report for the board to review.
- Chief Lemon reported that Brush 75 is out of service to replace the engine.

#### **Deputy Chief Operations Report:**

• Chief Donnell reported two bats entered into station 71 crew quarters on Sunday. We have contacted the proper authorities. One bat was captured and turned over to health department for testing. Lake Chelan Pest control came and searched for the second bat that was not found. The crew cleaned the quarters.





- Chief Donnell reported we have been doing fire wise assessments and installing residential smoke alarms.
- Chief Donnell met with Lake Chelan Homeowners Association to discuss fire wise measures and protecting themselves and property.
- Chief Donnell reported 2018 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter qualifications status stating we had 72 members and two have dropped out. We now have a total of 70 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2018.
- Chief Donnell reported we are 95% NIMS compliant.
- Chief Donnell reported the recently purchased staff vehicle was picked up last Friday and is having the light bars and decals installed.

#### **Assistance Chief of Volunteer Services:**

- Chief Asher reported the recruitment evaluations are trickling in. We have received good input that we can use to improve change for the next class.
- Chief Asher reported some of the recruits are coming to drill and a couple have gone on mobilizations.
- Chief Asher reported we have two new volunteer applications.
- Chief Asher reported station 71 has 12 more new volunteers than we did last year at this time. Station 72 2, Station 74 3.
- Chief Asher reported the volunteer stipend shift coverages for June are at 53%; 61% in July so far. The percentage should increase by end of July. Some of the stipend shifts are now being covered by some of the new recruits.
- Chief Asher reported he is working on the Explorer program.

#### **Firefighters Association Report:**

- President Dan Crandall reported the association's beginning account balance was \$36,247, and expenditures of \$2,671 and an ending balance of \$33,576.
- Rescue air bags ordered July 14, 2018 we should be getting them soon.
- A donation of \$2000 was given to the Apple Acres family who lost their home to fire last month.





• Jeanne Giddings was appointed as secretary of the association.

#### **Unfinished Business:**

- Annexation Issues: Chief Lemon reported a letter was sent to residents explaining the process. We continue to move forward with the survey company drafting the boundary changes. Those not interested in the annexation will be billed for the services if rendered. Once the boundaries are final, a public hearing will be scheduled.
- LCCH EMS Interagency Agreement with CFR: Chief Lemon reported he has yet to meet with them.

#### **New Business:**

• United States Supreme Court ruling in Janus v. AFSCME case: Chief Lemon reported the court has ruled union dues cannot be mandated. A letter will be drafted and sent to the members letting them know they have the option to pay or not pay the dues.
