Nicholson and Associates Presentation: District Insurance – Interlocal Agreement

- Pam Perkins, agent for Nicolson Insurance Agency, presented the costs and benefits of going into group insurance with Chelan County Fire District 5. The underwriter is North Central Washington Risk Management with VFIS, and Nicolson Insurance is the agent. Pam stated there are other fire districts who want to join the group along with Lake Chelan EMS.
- Deductibles will decrease in auto and facilities. *See current and new policy coverages spreadsheet comparable.
- Liability amounts will increase. *See current and new policy coverages spreadsheet comparable.
- Annual Cost \$38,418.57
- Renewal will take place in September 2024.

Fire Chief Report: (Chief Asher)

- 2023 Budget & Financial Report October 2023 Delayed
- October Emergency Response Report / Operations / Community Risk Reduction / Apparatus Update

2023 Budget & Financials:

• October Financials will be presented at the next meeting. Should still be well within budget. No major purchases.

Emergency Response Reports:

- October Incident Response Report shows 97 calls for emergency service with our 10-year average call volume for October at 71 calls. 2nd busiest October.
- Rescue/EMS responses accounted for 68% of total calls for service with 31% of those non-transport (includes patients who died at scene) or patient-transported POV which is a bit higher than normal.
- Major incidents for October: See PPT
- October turnout and response times (primary apparatus at Station 71) are within established service delivery goals in SOG 010.
- Effective Work Force: Effective workforce was acceptable for call types.
- Total fire loss for October is \$25,000 no tax loss since not taxable property.

Administration:

• ESO migration is ongoing. We are waiting for Rivercom to get the CAD integration complete so we can train on filling outcalls on ESO.

• TIF—We have fallen farther apart in the mitigation with the City of Chelan. The city has our mitigation plan, their mitigation plan, and the option of waiting till 2024. We must have an annual report showing the additional calls from within the TIF area anyway. Their plan of 95% occupancy and 10% of overall district call volume did not work for me. We will continue to try and finalize a plan as soon as possible. Attorney Quinn is active in our negotiation process.

• Station 244 in Orondo is officially open and has been added to WSRB's website. Since we have it as automatic aid through dispatch, we will also get credit in the Chelan Falls area for that.

• The Commissioner's conference was a couple of weeks ago Commissioner Jones, Karla, and I attended. There was a lot of good information and TIF was the hot topic.

Operations:

- FF Fogelson is back to regular duty as the Floater.
- Shift bids have been completed. Karla is working on the 2024 shift calendar.





Community Risk Reduction/Events:

• A lot of fire prevention items were given out during the Halloween event.

Apparatus Status:

- Fire capabilities of the boat is still a work in progress.
- Yesterday there was a surplus command vehicle grant that became available through the DNR. We applied because we could really use one more command/staff vehicle. If the quality isn't up to par we can always just turn it down.
- Mechanic Miller repaired the ladder slow turn to the right on L71.
- The type 3 brush truck is still going through its refurbishment. It is awaiting its new pump and should be ready for the final inspection the first week of December.
- <u>Spartan engines</u> are moving along. We're still hoping to do the final in mid-January.
- We are still holding onto E73 for now until we get a clearer picture on when we'll get the new Spartans.

Stations:

• Station 71 generator update. Still a very frustrating project. We're waiting to hear back from an Orondo electrician. We're now thinking about making it a mobile setup. Especially with the thought of future station construction.
