Job Announcement 2024 Seasonal Firefighter Position

Chelan Fire & Rescue seeks three individuals to join our organization as Seasonal Firefighters for the 2024 fire season. The selected individuals will work as fourth firefighters in providing emergency service response and community risk reduction programs to the Chelan Fire & Rescue community. These members will also participate in state mobilizations throughout the 2024 Wildfire Season.

CLOSING DATE: March 15, 2024

WAGES: \$18.97 to \$24.67 (2023 WA State Wage & Equipment Rates) base rate depending upon qualifications. Medical, dental, and vision insurance included, PERS retirement—no other paid benefits. When published, rates will be adjusted to the updated 2024 WA State Wage & Equipment Rate.

OPEN TO: This position is open to all individuals currently in good standing with their respective Fire District/Department that has maintained their required training and meets the minimum qualification requirements at the time of employment and as agreed to by the Fire Chief.

NUMBER OF POSITIONS TO BE FILLED: 1

FLSA STATUS: This position is an at-will employment position assigned a 24-day cycle. The typical work week shall be 56 hours per calendar week on a 48/96 schedule. Any regular hours over the FSLA limit shall be paid equal to one-half times the regular rate. Personnel on a 24-day (56-hours/week) shift cycle are scheduled off for one 24-hour shift to reduce the work week to 49 hours.

START/END DATES: The seasonal Firefighter position will start on April 25, 2024, and end on October 24, 2024. This position may be extended past the October 24th end date depending on the fire season length and approval by the Board of Commissioners. This temporary (seasonal) full-time position is not covered under the Chelan Fire & Rescue/IAFF Local 4816 Bargaining Agreement.

THE POSITION: The Seasonal Firefighter position will supplement our current staffing during our seasonal uptake in call volume providing 4 Firefighters on shift daily. The Seasonal Firefighter work responsibilities include the following: responding to and dealing with emergencies, natural conditions that threaten life and property, and incidents of

service to the citizens. Additionally, employees in this position are responsible for protecting life and property through firefighting activities, emergency medical services, community risk reduction programs, and other duties as outlined in the Firefighter/EMT Job Description.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Current member in good standing with Chelan Fire & Rescue or respective Fire District/Department.
- Must possess a valid Washington State Driver's License and EVIP card.
- Successful completion of Basic Firefighter Recruit Academy or completion of a fire service recruit training program approved by the Fire Chief.
- Red Card Certified, Wildland Firefighter Type 2 (Firefighter Type 1 preferred.)
- Current WA State EMT credential, preferred but not required.
- IFSAC Firefighter I/II, Hazmat Operations, preferred but not required.

TO APPLY: Send a cover letter stating your interest in the position and a signed copy of the Firefighter/EMT Job Description. Copies of all required credentials must be on file with the Administrative Office Staff before the Candidate Interview date. Please complete and submit the Application. Those affiliated with Chelan Fire and Rescue do not need to complete the application.
